Oscar is also the Head of Economic Planning Department at the Faculty, and the Chairman of the Planning and Statistics Office of the Economy vice Rectory at the University of Havana. Oscar has participated on seminars in Spain and Jamaica. His main research interests are the innovation themes and the planned economies procedure. He has published various papers. He is also a Member of the Provincial Assembly of Popular Power in Havana, on which is head of the Committee for Science, Innovation and Environment issues.
